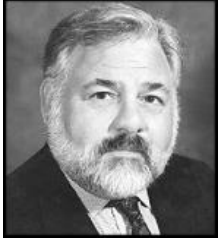

Alan I. Scheer



SCHEER, Alan I. Alan I. Scheer, 62, of Essex, died on Monday (January 10, 2005). Born in Yonkers, NY, he was the son of the late Harold Scheer and Malvene Arce. He was a practicing attorney specializing in labor, employment and healthcare law in Hartford for many years, and worked in Bridgeport and Meriden as well. At the time of his death, he was general counsel for Hebrew Health Care in West Hartford. Mr. Scheer did his undergraduate work at Cornell and New York University and received his Juris Doctor from Brooklyn Law School in 1967. He was a member of the Connecticut Bar Association Board of Governors, its House of Delegates, its Executive Committee, and Chairman of its Labor and Employment Law section. A long time supporter of the arts, he was a former member of the Board of Directors of the Hartford Symphony Orchestra, a Trustee of New Haven's Long Wharf Theatre, and Executive Vice President of the Hartford Chamber Orchestra. Mr. Scheer is survived by his sister, Judy Scheer of New York City, NY; his step father, Dr. Anthony Arce of Elkins Park, PA; friends, Irving and Jean Farber of Bedford, NY, Jane Finger of Fairhope, AL, and Janet Youmans of Avon; and the family of the late Toby Messenger, whose friendship played a significant part in his life. The funeral will be TODAY, January 13, 2 p.m. at Congregation Beth Shalom, 55 East Kings Highway, Chester, with internment at the Riverview Cemetery in Essex.
